

## **Karona Fire Door Installation Instructions**

## 20 Minute Neutral Pressure

- 1. Trimming for height may be done on the bottom rail only. Maximum trim of 3/4" (0.75") allowed on site.
- 2. Surface mounted hardware must be attached with through bolts.
- 3. A maximum of 1/8" (0.125") gap is allowed between the door and frame or leaves of a pair.
- 4. Do not remove, cover, or paint over the attached fire label.
- 5. If a **continuous hinge** is used, the label shall be placed on the top of the door.

## 20 Minute Positive Pressure, 45/60 Minute Positive Pressure, 90 Minute Positive Pressure

- 1. Trimming for height may be done on the bottom rail only. Maximum trim of 3/4" (0.75") allowed on site.
- 2. Surface mounted hardware must be attached with through bolts.
- 3. A maximum of 1/8" (0.125") gap is allowed between the door and frame or leaves of a pair.
- 4. This door does not require the application of an additional edge-sealing system.
  - \* A fire rated smoke and draft control gasket shall be installed for a smoke rating. Must be UBC 7-2-1997 approved.
- 5. Minimum of a 16 gauge welded steel frame is required. GP Firestop Plus or other UBC 7-2-1997 approved frames.
- 6. There are no special hardware installations allowed.
- 7. Do not remove, cover, or paint over the attached **fire label**.
- 8. If a continuous hinge is used, the label shall be placed on the top of the door.
- 9. A positive pressure approved **closing device** must be used in all applications.
- 10. Approved viewers may be installed according to manufacturers instructions.
- 11. **Protection plates** are allowed. Maximum of 16" high using #6 x 3/4" fully threaded wood screws with 6" spacing around the perimeter of the plate

## General

Fire doors are generally heavier than unrated doors and different core materials are used to achieve ratings.

- 1. Always **pre-drill** to 95% of the screw shank size the full depth of the screw. (see illustration A)
- 2. Screws shall be 2" minimum to 3" maximum in length for all fire door applications.
  - \* If screw removal is necessary, a threaded insert may be required to re-hang the doors. (see illustration B)
- 4. A minimum of 3-4.5" NFPA 80 approved **hinges** are required on all fire door installations.
  - \* 4 hinges are recommended on doors over 84".


